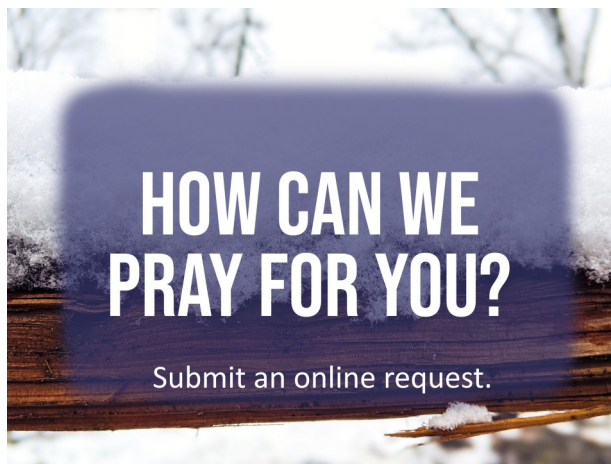
The West Side Brethren in Christ Church exists to help people come to know God personally and develop into mature followers of Jesus Christ.
