The West Side Youth Group exists to cultivate a generation for the purpose of Christ.

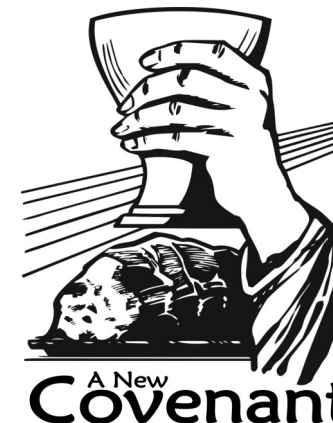
